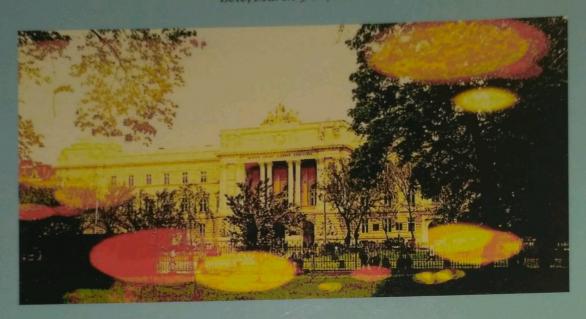

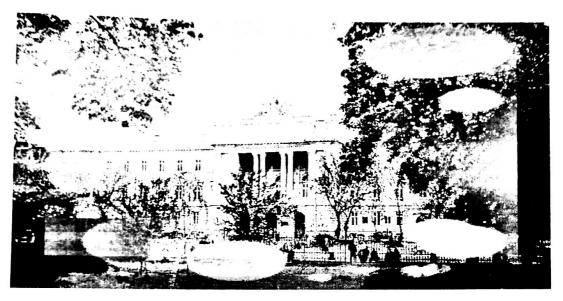

FORMATION OF CULTURAL SELF-CONSCIOUSNESS OF THE FUTURE **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS**

The formation of the national educational system in Ukraine takes place in conditions of accelerated entry into the world community. Further development of the country depends to a large extent on the personality of the teacher of elementary school, which has an exceptional impact on



the formation of national consciousness, value orientations, moral qualities, aesthetic views of students and their beliefs. The teacher at the same time serves as a spiritual mentor for younger students, a leader of social and historical experience, educator, and organizer.

Thus, the priority in the training of primary school teachers is to become aware about the unbreakable unity of all Ukrainian people, in spite of nationality, religion, language, traditions, customs and the formation of cultural consciousness. Conceptual understanding and solution of the problem which is dealt with the primary school teachers' preparation will promote the upbringing of activity, initiative and autonomy in the younger generation as the necessary values of a modern person in the transitional period of the Ukrainian society development.

Self-consciousness is the ability of a person to realize himself, his needs, interests, values, his being and his meaning, his own behavior and experiences, and so on. Unlike consciousness, self-consciousness is focused on understanding by the person his actions, feelings, thoughts, motives of behavior, interests, his position in the society. If consciousness is knowledge of the other person, then self-consciousness is the knowledge of a person about himself. If consciousness is oriented to the whole objective world, then the object of self-consciousness is the person himself. In self-consciousness, it appears both as a subject and as an object of cognition.

The central and most studied structural components of self-consciousness are the phenomena of self-regulation, self-evaluation, self-examination. Each child is born as an individual of the human race. However, in the process of life, not everyone becomes a person. The personality is considered a self-regulating system (I.P. Pavlov).
